

QOMO HiteVision enjoys amazing response to new products at INFOCOMM 2008.

Las Vegas, NV, June 18, 2008 – QOMO HiteVision introduced 6 new products at INFOCOMM 2008.

Leading the charge was the new **QPC30** portable document camera. Featuring a 1.3 MP CMOS sensor, SXGA native resolution, 3X optical zoom, a new design concept and a host of advance features generated tremendous interest among the attendees. The **QPC30** is scheduled to be available in September 2008.



In addition to the new portable **QOMO** also introduced a new full size document camera unit the **QD6100SX**. The **QD6100SX** breaks new ground for **QOMO** in the full size category, with advanced features such as a 10X optical Zoom lens, advanced digital zoom and a 2.0 MP CMOS sensor for greater than SXGA resolution and the ability to do 16:10 format WXGA (1280 x 800) resolution to match today's and tomorrow's high resolution displays. The **QD6100SX** is slated for release by Q4 2008.

QOMO also debut its new **QClick** RF audience response systems models: the **QRF300** and **QRF600**. The QRF300 represents a cost effective and reliable solution featuring intuitive PowerPoint based software with predefined exam/response formats, wide operating range with RF technology, instructor remote incorporating all necessary functionalities at finger tips, and versatile reporting tools for performance measurement. QRF600 further extends the functionalities with 6-line LCD display, alpha-numeric input allowing decimal numbers and fractions, take-home exam capability, flexibility in hardware setting, and informative status display. Both models are suitable for traditional classroom settings, group meetings, or wherever instant feedback is desired. The **QOMO QClick** systems are easy to learn and fun to use. It enriches presentations and classroom curricula by encouraging participation. Real-time feedback can be electronically collected at the simple click of a button.



Qomo HiteVision used the show as an opportunity to gauge US market reaction to two new Microscope Cameras. These units are currently on sale in Asia and gaining lots of accolades. Response at INFOCOMM was very positive to the new units and everyone was asking about availability. The **QSU110** is a 1 mega pixel unit the only requires a USB connection to the resident PC. Through the supplied software images can be manipulated and saved. The other unit model **QSC100** uses a composite video connection allowing it to be used with standard TVs or directly connected to a projector. Both units feature high quality optics and fit most standard microscopes.
