QOMO HiteVision announces the new QPC60 standalone portable document camera. The new QPC60 document camera incorporates all the high end features you come to expect in a new generation portable document camera. These high end features include a 5.0 MP CMOS sensor, HDMI video output, SD card slot, microscope adaptor and a remote control with built in laser pointer.

What makes the QPC60 really stand out from the rest is its very powerful standalone multimedia capabilities. This unique multimedia system includes a built in microphone, built in speaker and built in full color LCD display. This complete multimedia package makes it possible to use this highly compact and portable device to record MP4 video presentations with audio directly to the built in SD card without connecting a computer. Recorded videos and audio can be played back and previewed with the onboard color LCD display and speaker. Once satisfied with the recorded presentation, the SD card can be removed from the standalone QPC60 document camera and used in any computer or playback device. The highly compressed MP4 recording format provides excellent quality video and audio requiring the least amount of memory.

A document camera must be able to create high quality images and the QPC60 excels in this category. The camera features 3X optical zoom and a 5.0 MP image sensor that adds another 2X optical quality smart zoom. The highly flexible mechanical camera arm adds another 8X mechanical zoom and is further supported with a very powerful Macro Mode for extremely close up imaging. The end result is a 48X optical quality zoom system. The QPC60 also supports an additional 4X digital zoom for extreme applications requiring up to 192X total zoom.

To take full advantage of the camera's high quality optics, macro mode and magnification, the QPC60 LCD display can be used as a lighted stage for viewing color slides, negatives and even microscope slides. The resulting images and live video can be viewed via the HDMI port in 720P high definition.

The new QPC60 portable document camera's software system supports various presentation modes including: Picture in Picture, image highlighter and mask, image rotation and freeze frame. When the QPC60 is connected to a computer via the USB port, the SD card contents can be mounted on the computer like a standard removable storage device making it extremely easy to manage video files and images stored on the SD card.
