



# Jackson, AL School Raises Test Scores with QOMO Interactive Whitboards!

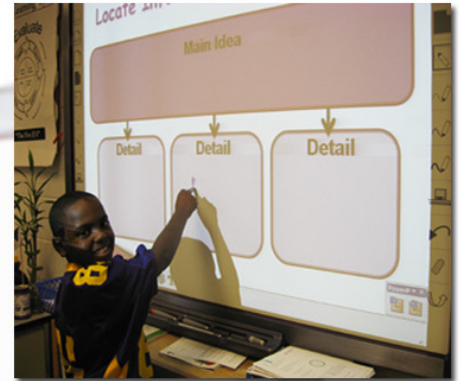
