

# QoVision Editor Quick Start Guide

## PART I: How to Create A New Project


### 1. Start Editor

Once you have loaded the program, double click on the Editor icon on your desktop.

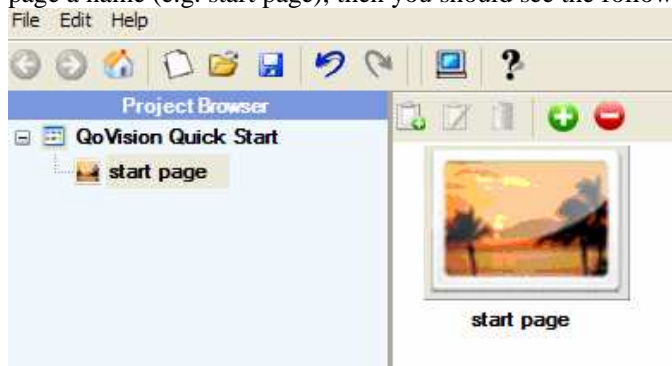
### 2. Create A New Project


Click on “New Project” and type project name (e.g. QoVision Quick Start).

### 3. Create Page

3.1 Click on the “add page” icon. 


3.2 You will now have a page icon  Single left click on page name and give your page a name (e.g. start page), then you should see the following.

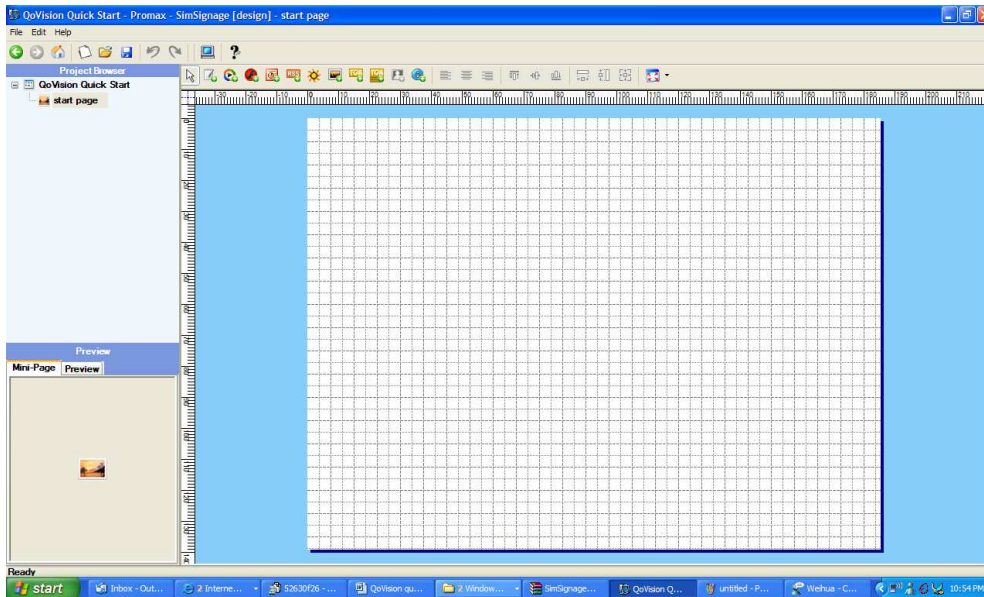


3.3 Now double click on .

There is now a grid pattern with a series of icons showing various content items above it. This is our page.

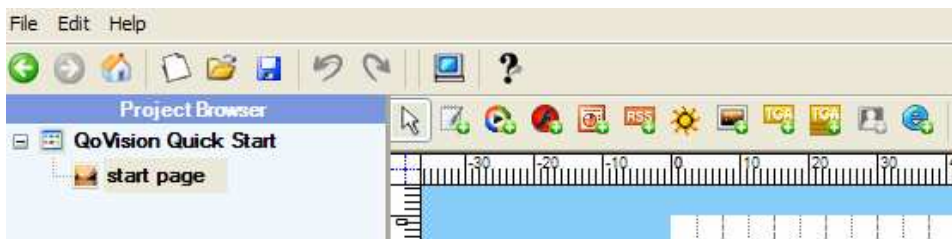
3.4 You must first determine which aspect ratio you will desire to work in. Click on











the aspect ratio icon  located at the far right side of the screen above the grid page. You can choose from 4:3, 16:9, 1:1, 9:16, and 3:4. It is best to determine the aspect ratio so you can see how your various items will look on the page.



#### 4. Create zones and add elements


QoVision software allows you to create multiple zones on the page and add elements in the zones. You can select from many different elements.

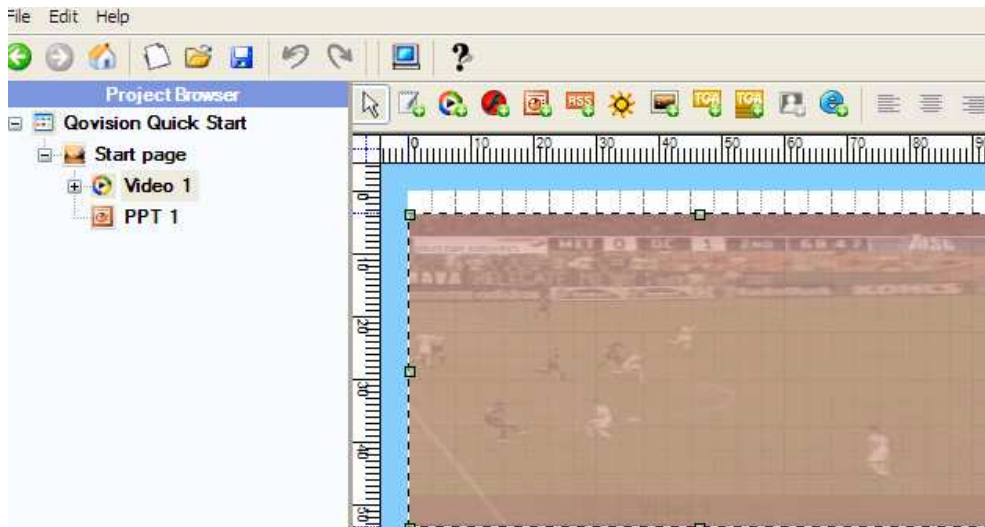


You can choose to add elements such as: text , video , flash , ppt , RSS , weather , background , TGA , website , live TV  if you have TV tuner card connected.

Select the type of element you want to add to your page.

##### 4.1 Add video


4.1.1 Click on the video icon , then holding down the left mouse button, “draw” your video window on your page to create video zone. The video zone can be as large or as small as you wish. Once you have drawn the zone, it will appear as “video 1”, you will also see it appear in the left side under Project Browser.

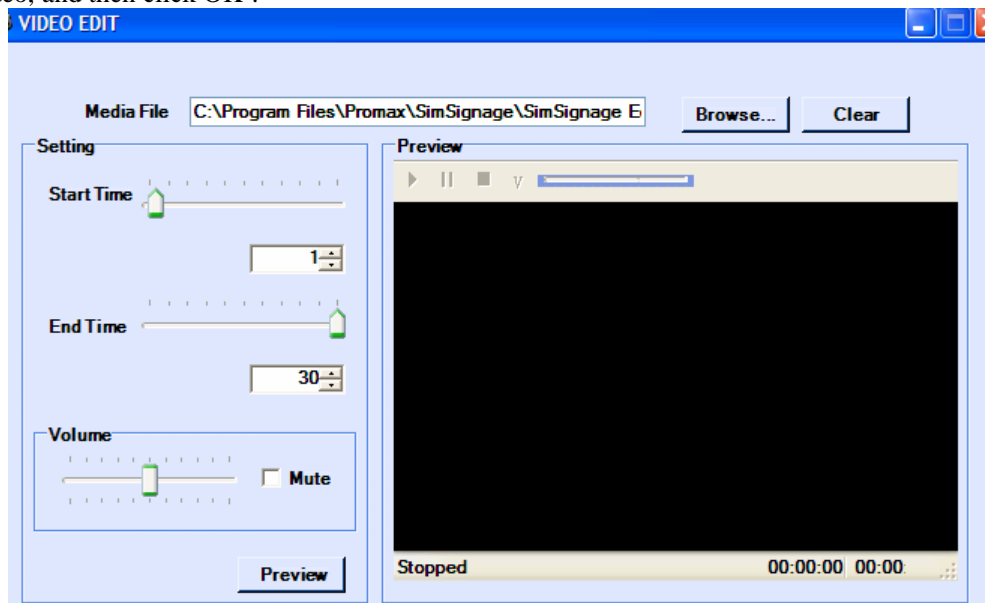


4.1.2 Double click on the 'Video 1' field you just drew.

4.1.3 Click on the add item icon, then 'Item 0' will appear under Item list.



4.1.4 Double click on  and it will take you to the video edit screen. Click on the Browse button to find your video file. On the video edit screen, be sure to indicate a start and stop time for your video file. You may also adjust the volume or simply mute the audio. Click the preview button to be sure you have selected the correct video, and then click OK'.



You have added Item 0.


4.1.5 You can repeat step 4.1.3-4.1.4 if you want to add more Items.

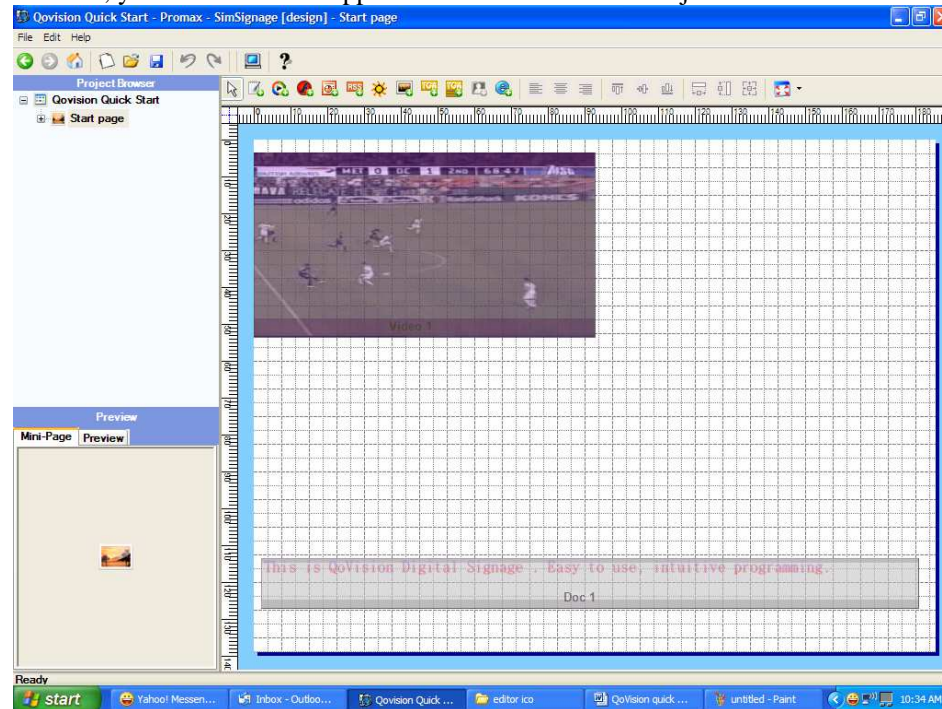
#### 4.1.6 Add sequence

Simply drag and drop the Items to the bottom sequence box.

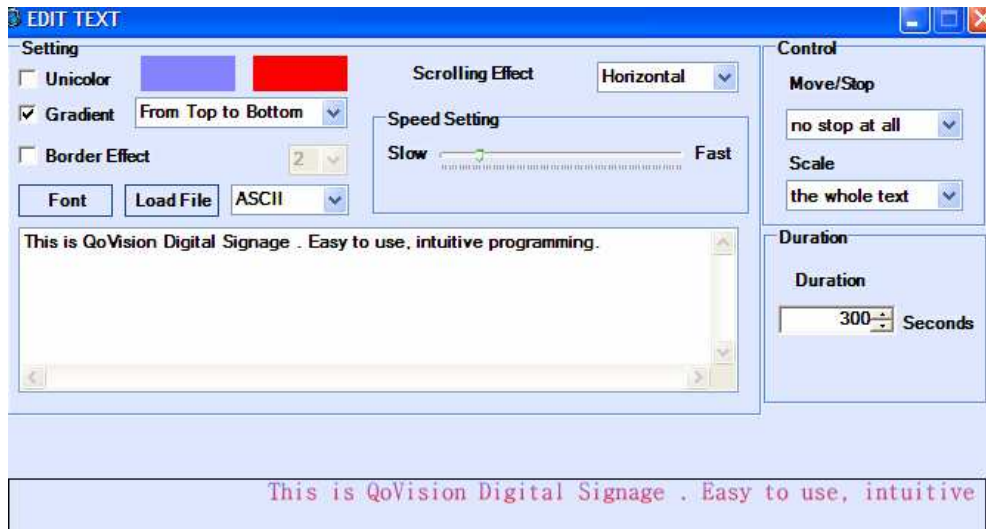
#### 4.2 Add Text

Return to the page by clicking 'Start Page' on the left under project browser.

4.2.1 Click on the Text icon , then holding down the left mouse button, "draw" your Text window on your page. Once you have drawn the field, it will appear as "Doc 1", you will also see it appear in the left side under Project Browser.




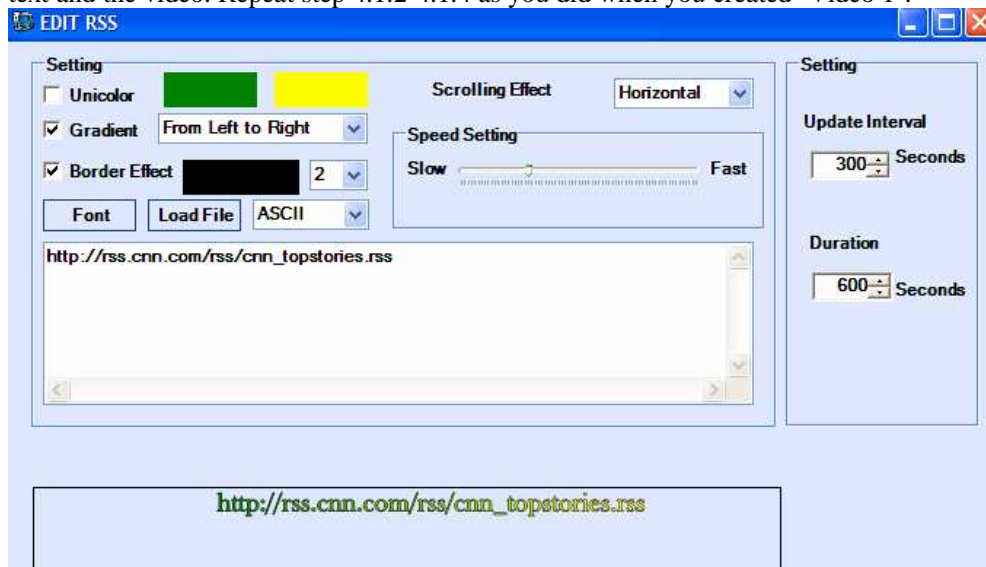
4.2.2 Now, just as you did with the video selection in step 4.1.2-4.1.4, click on the DOC 1 box, then the add item icon above the item list, then click on the Item icon once it appears in the item list; this will take you to the Edit Text box. Here, you can type your text message, or copy a prepared document from MS word file, or load an existing text file. You can also choose font style and size, color, scrolling effect, speed and direction, as well as the time duration for your text message to appear.



#### 4.3 Add RSS

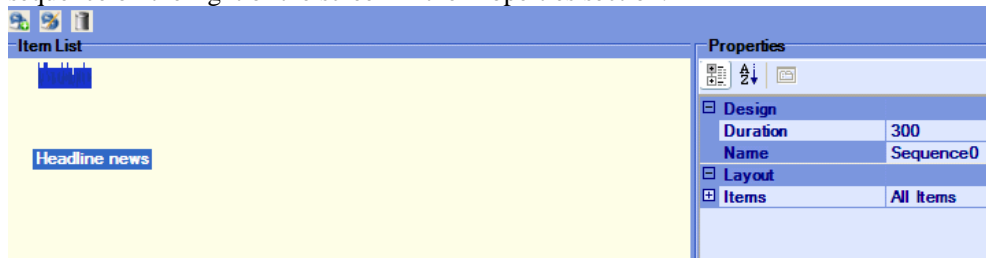
One of the features unique to QoVision is the ability to create RSS windows quickly and easily. Return to the page by clicking 'Start Page' on the left under project browser.

4.3.1 Click on the RSS icon . Draw your box on the page just as you did for the text and the video. Repeat step 4.1.2-4.1.4 as you did when you created 'Video 1'.




4.3.2 Copy/Paste RSS links to the box. You can also choose font style and size, color, scrolling effect, speed and direction, Update Interval, as well as the time duration for RSS to appear. You can select preview to make sure the RSS displayed is what you want then click OK.

As with all of the visual items of QoVision, you will see the name, duration and sequence on the right of the screen in the Properties section.

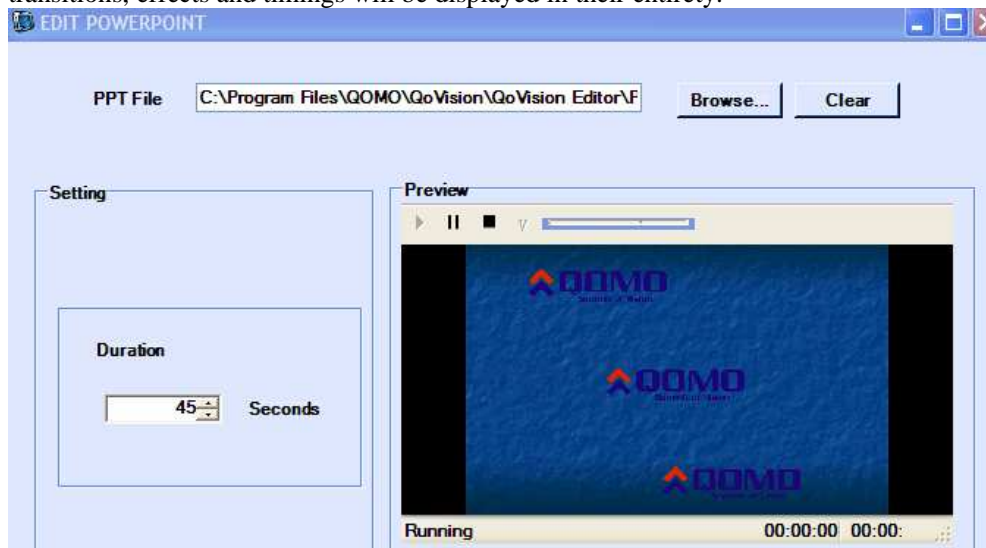


#### 4.4 Add PPT (PowerPoint)

4.4.1 Go to page window and click on the .ppt icon .


4.4.2 Now, just as you did with the video selection in step 4.1.2-4.1.4, click on the PPT box, then the add item icon above the item list, then click on the Item icon once it appears in the item list; this will take you to the Edit .PPT box.

4.4.3 Using the browse function, search and select the .ppt file you want and add that into the Edit.PPT box. This .PPT will be added in its complete file format. All of your transitions, effects and timings will be displayed in their entirety.



#### 4.5 Add Website

One of the more unique features of using QoVision content editor is the ability to create a live “web” window which will play as long as you are connected to the internet. You can even stream live video from the internet using this feature.

4.5.1 Click on the Page you want to have this appear and click on the Web icon. .

4.5.2. Draw your box on the page just as you did for the text and the video. Repeat step 4.1.2-4.1.4 as you did when you created ‘Video 1’.


4.5.3 Click on the Web box and this will take you to the Edit Webpage box. Type in the web address and hit preview to be sure this is the site you desire.

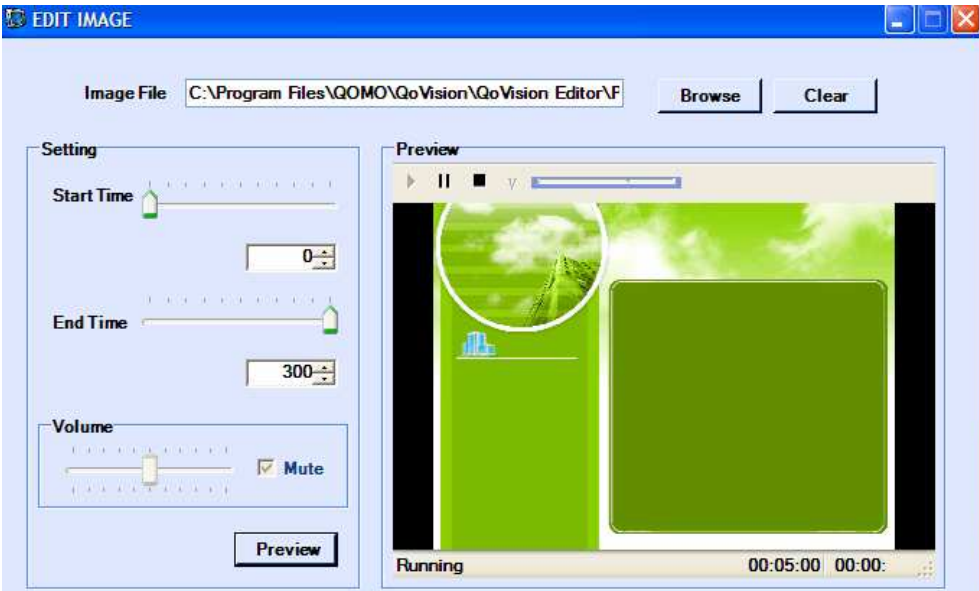


#### 4.6 Add Background

Now, to make this page look good and to personalize the page for your company or school, we can add a background.

Go back to the opening page.

4.6.1 Click on the picture icon  Repeat step 4.1.2-4.1.4 as you did when you created Video 1 to create PIC 1. Repeat step 4.1.2-4.1.4 to create more pictures if you like.



4.6.2 Browse through your library, select the background and click OK

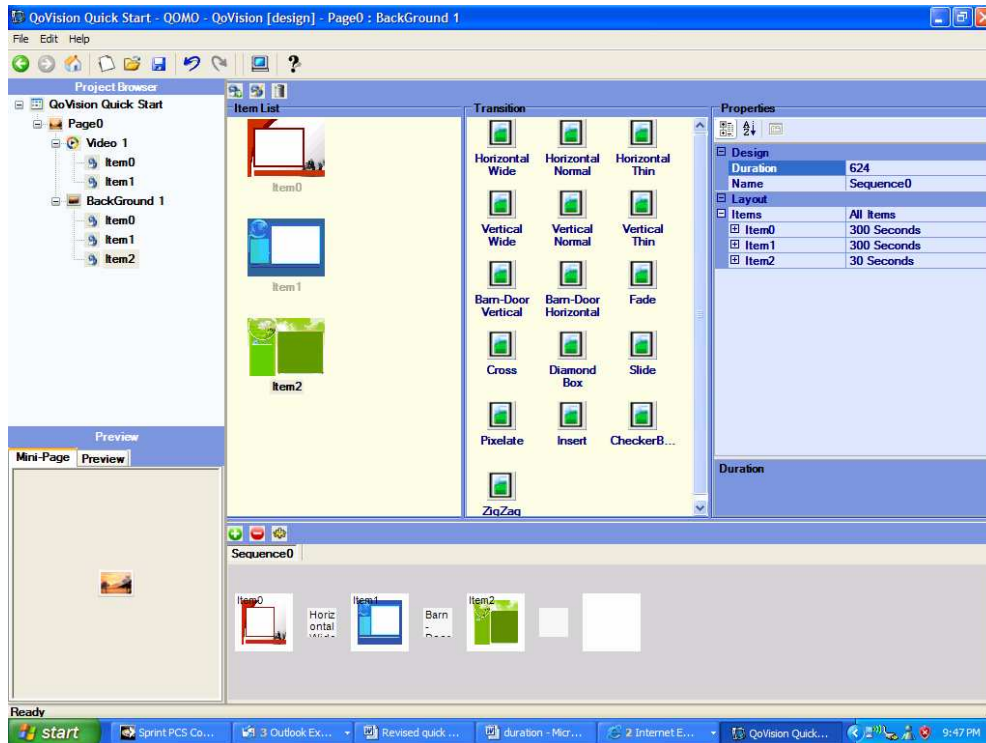
### 5 About Items Sequence and Page Sequence

The Sequence has two purposes. First, the Sequence defines the order of the items of the element within the zone on your page. When you have a zone with multiple items playing in the same zone at different times, you will have to provide a Sequence for those items. We call this Item Sequence.

The second purpose of the Sequence is to define the order of all of the pages that you want to show in the project. We call this Page Sequence.

### 6 Add Items to the Sequence

Drag/drop the pictures to the sequence box on the bottom.



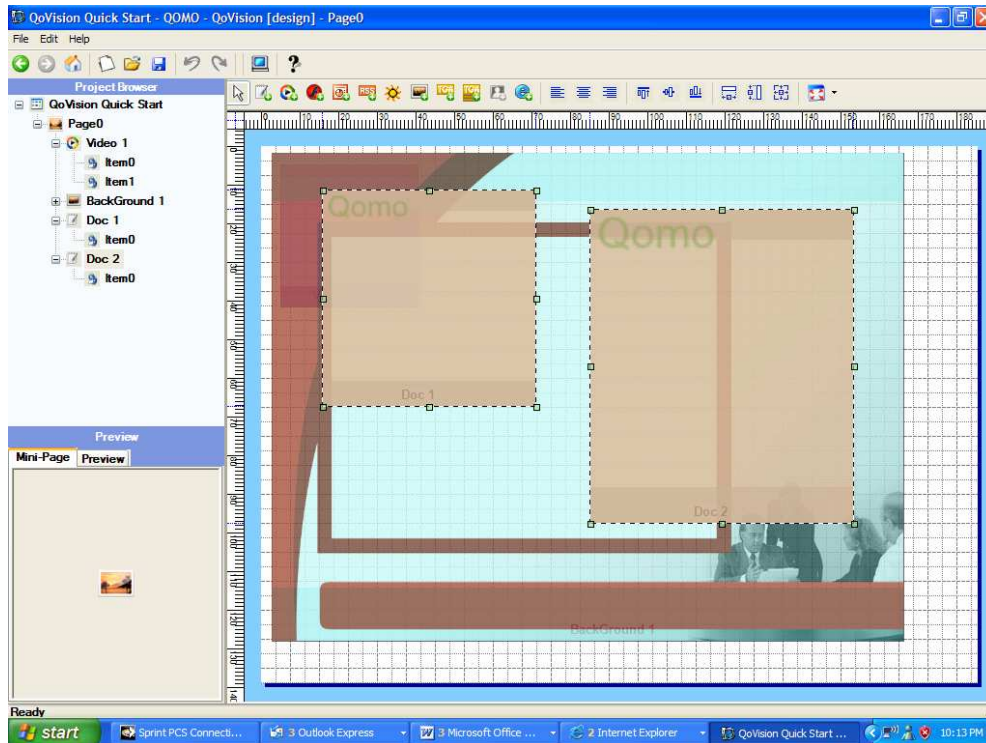
## 7. Add Transition between Items

You can add transition effect between pictures by drag/drop the transition you like from the center box to the sequence box on the bottom.

## 8. Duration

The duration of the zone is the sum of all the items in that zone; it's shown at the right upper corner under Properties. The duration of the page that consists of multiple zones is the maximum duration of all the zones.

## 9. Page Layout: Zones/Elements Arrangement



9.1 Bring to front, send to back control for each element on the page

You can have multiple layers of various elements one on top of the other. To control each element on the page, right click on your mouse, choose 'bring the element to the front' or 'send it to back'.

9.2 Zone sizing and positioning

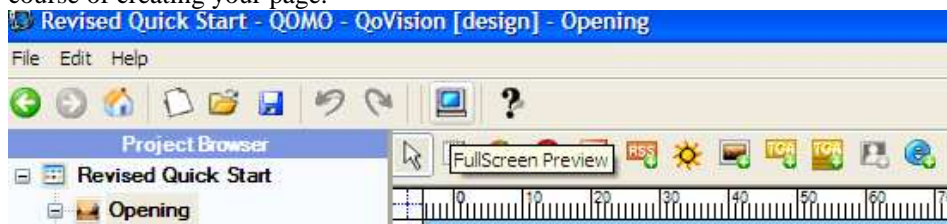
Just single click on the zone you want to modify, and then drag the box to change the size or position.

9.3 Auto alignment of each zone on the page

Select the zones you'd like to align by holding 'ctrl' key and clicking on the zones, and then select the alignment from the top bars.

## 10 Preview/Close Preview

10.1 After you have completed your page design, click on the Preview icon to see if the page needs to be edited. You can run the preview whenever you desire during the course of creating your page.



10.2 Click on 'close' button to close preview window. If you can't see the 'close' button, hit 'alt' + 'f4' keys together, then you should see 'close' button, click 'close' button to close the preview window.

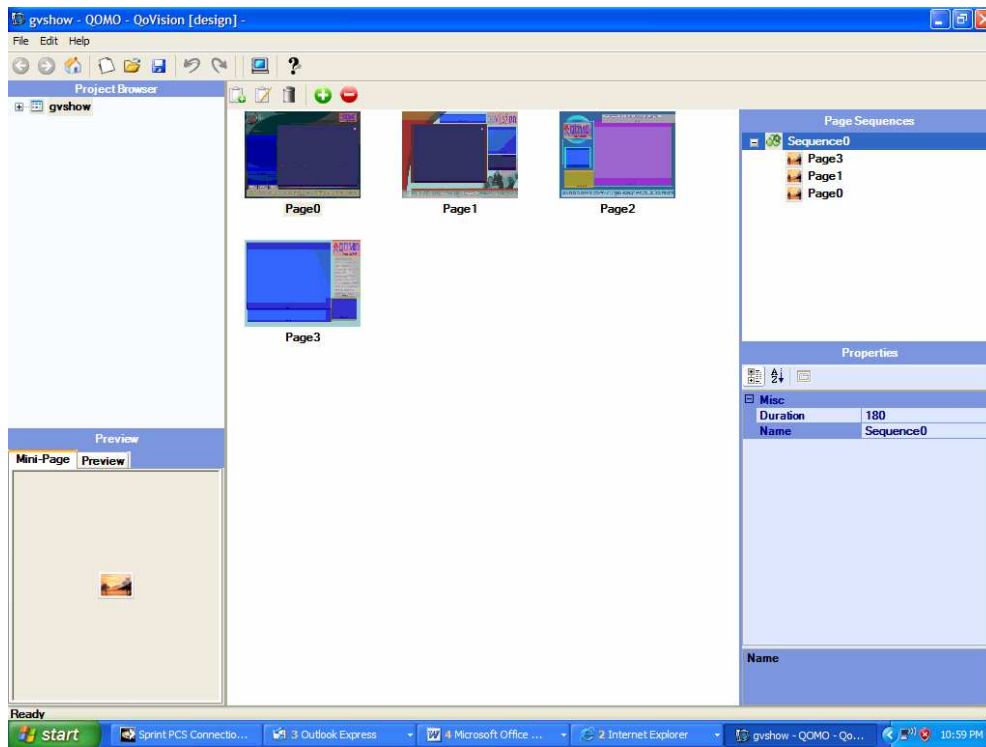

## 11. Add Pages to the Page Sequence



Add the page that you desire to show to the Page Sequence by drag/drop it to right under Sequence0. Your project will show only the pages in the Page Sequence.

## PART II: How to Modify Project

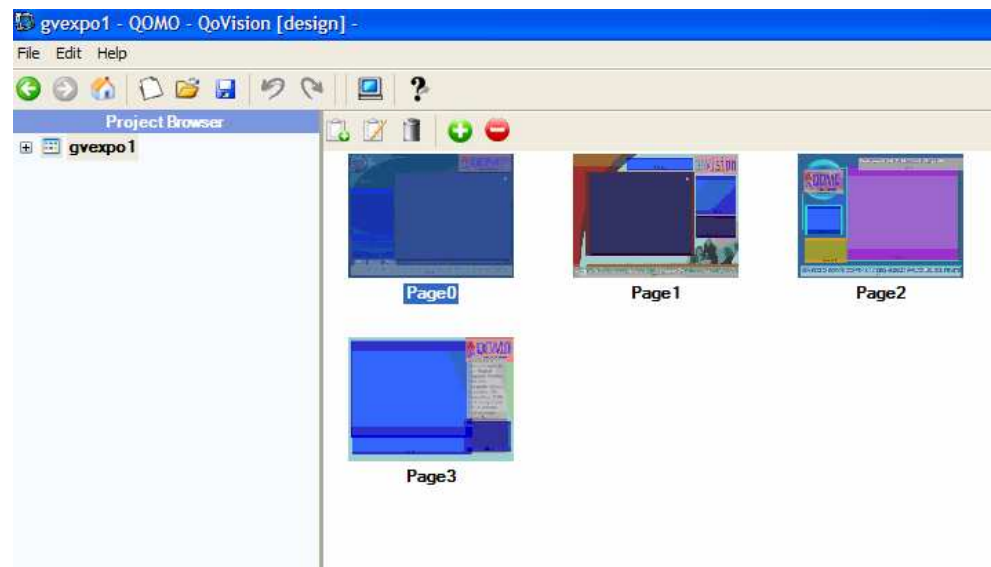
### 1. Start Editor

Once you have loaded the program, double click on the Editor icon on your desktop.

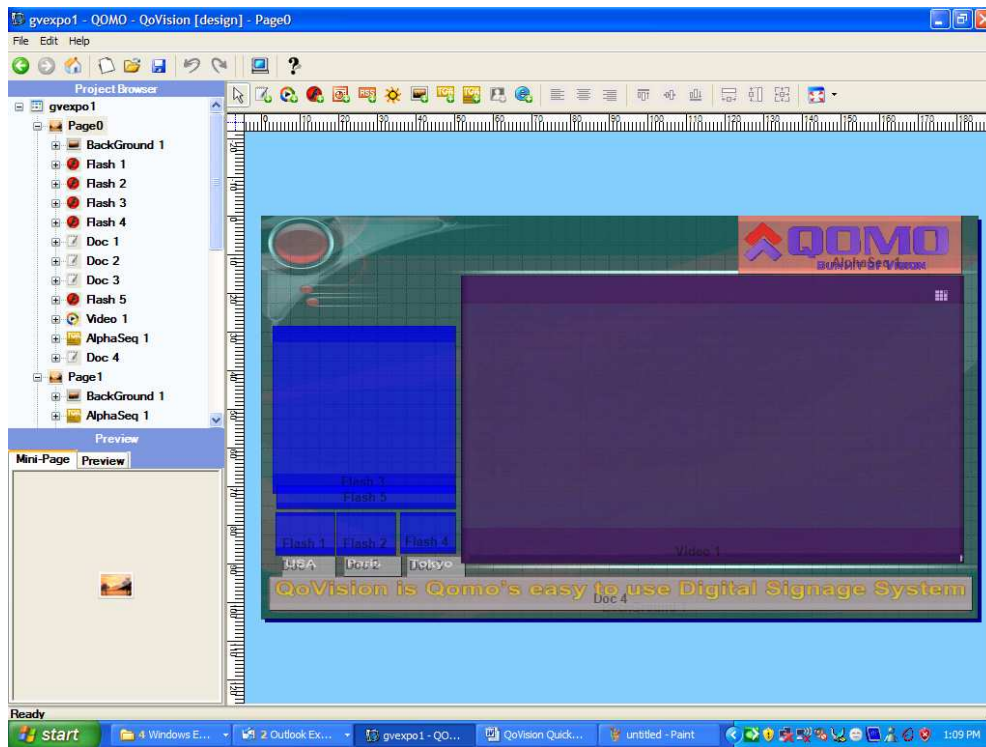
### 2. Open Project

Click on 'Open Project' and select project name (gvexpo1).

### 3. Modify Pages

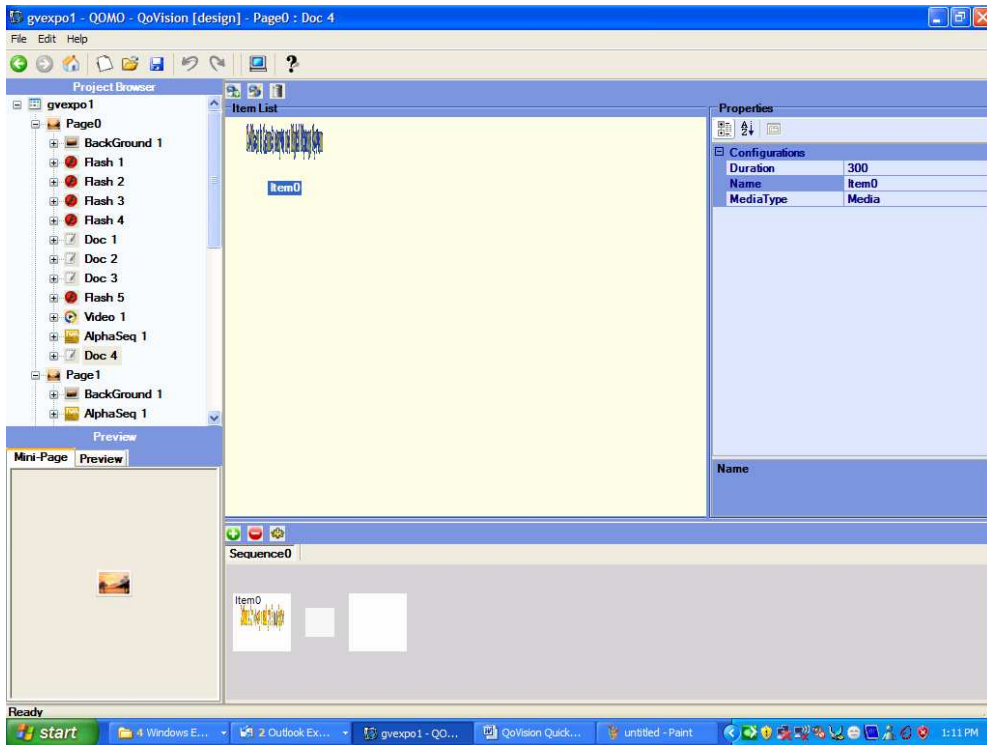


3.1 Click on the "page 0" icon, you should see the following page window (page 0).

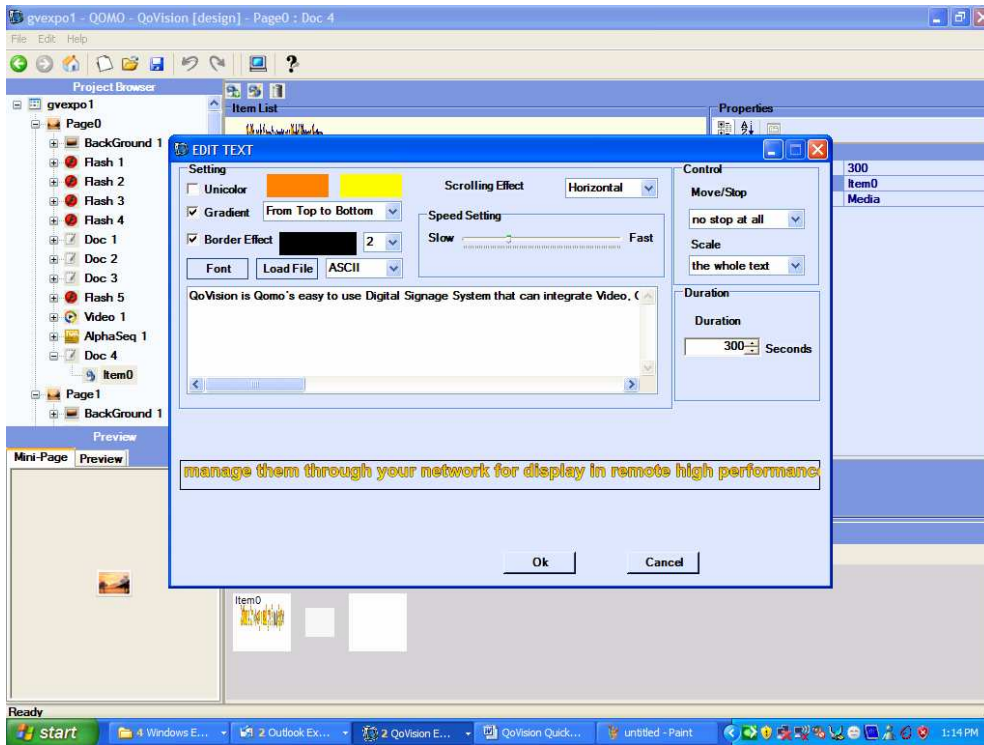


### 3.2 Change Text

Double click on Doc 4 at the bottom, you should see the following window.



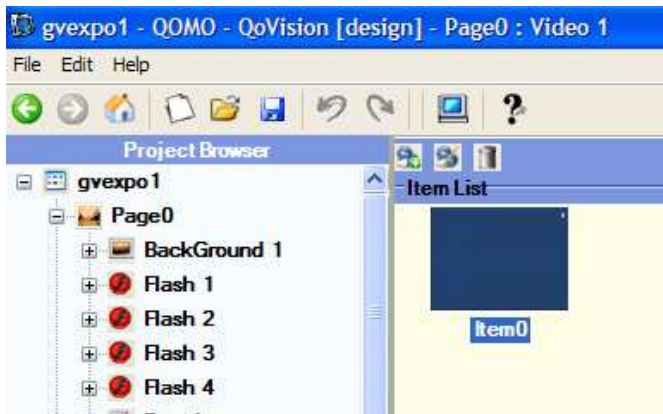
Double click on item 0, and change the text in the box, then click on OK.



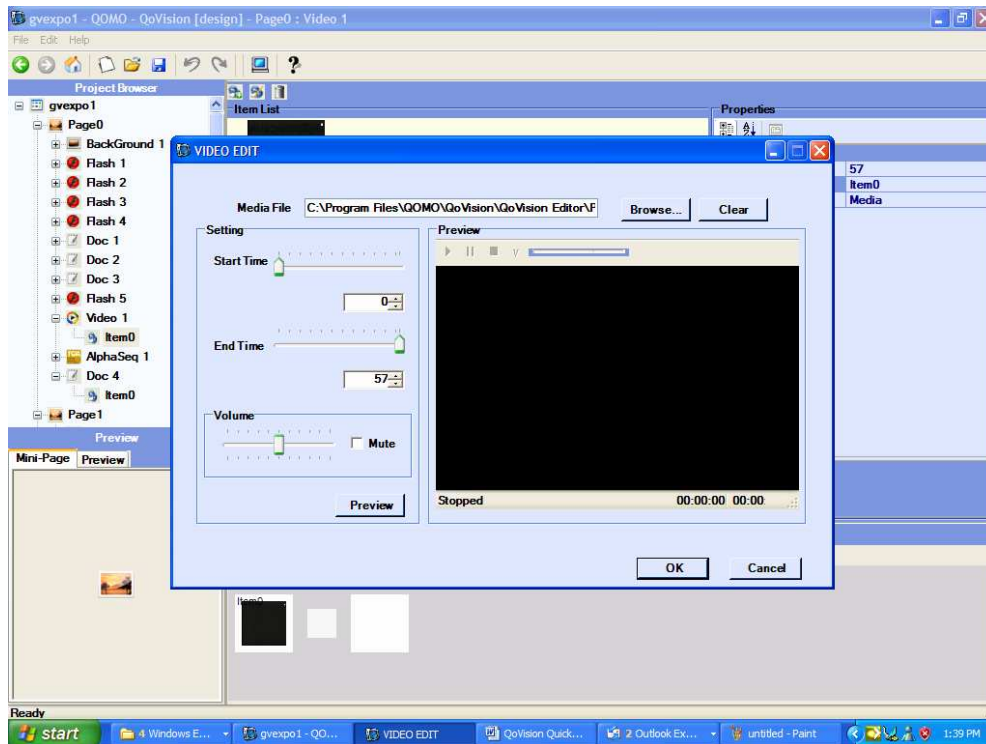
Click on 'page 0' under 'Project Browser' at the left upper corner to go back the page window.

### 3.3 Change Video

Double click on 'Video 1' on page window, you should see the following window.



Double click on 'Item0', and then go to Media File Browser to select the video file you want, select 'OK'.




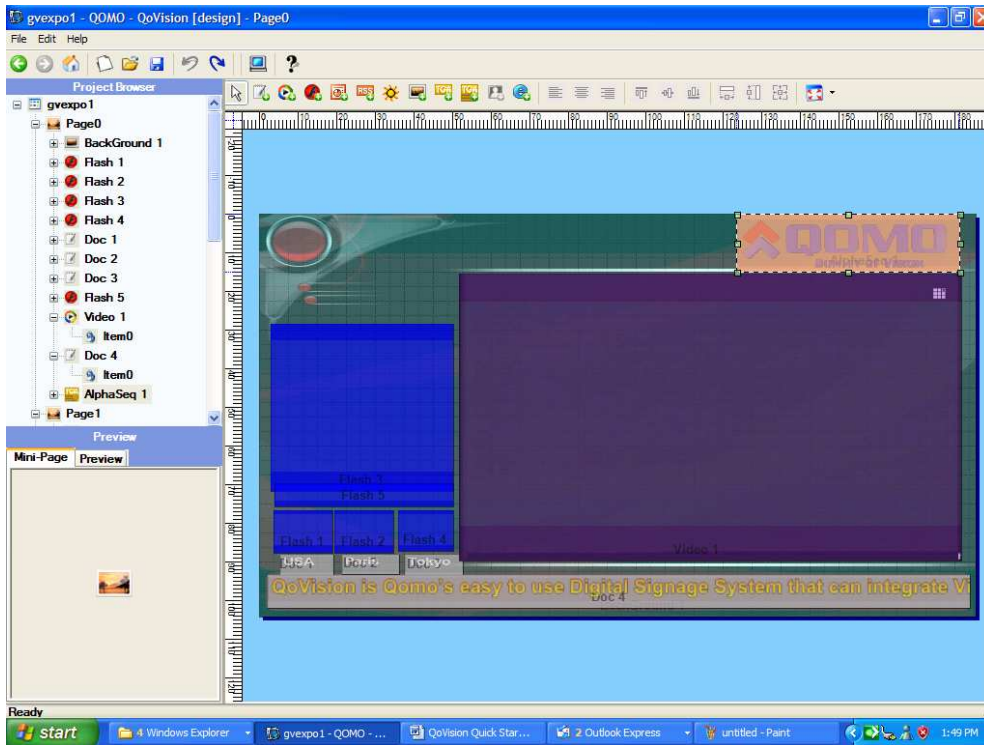
Click on 'page 0' under 'Project Browser' at the left upper corner to go back the page window.

### 3.4 Change Logo

If you have TGA file (animation such as we are showing), then modify it following the same steps as you change video file. If you don't have TGA file, but have jpg file for your Logo, then do the following steps.

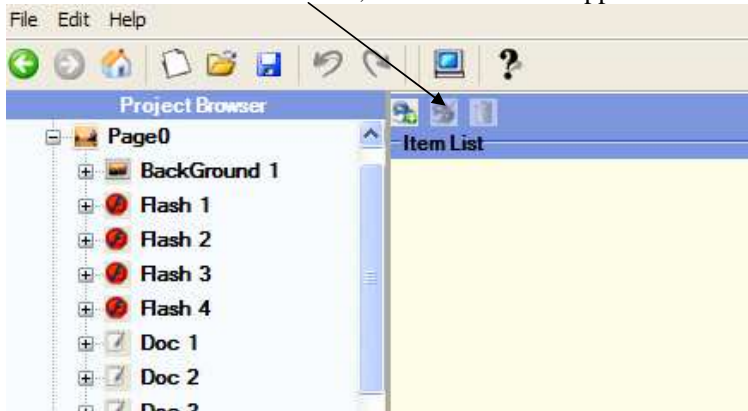
3.4.1 Single click on the 'QOMO' logo on the page window, then delete it.


3.4.2 Click on , then drag a box on the page window where you want the logo located. Then double click on the box.



3.4.3 Click on the add item icon, then 'Item 0' will appear under Item list.

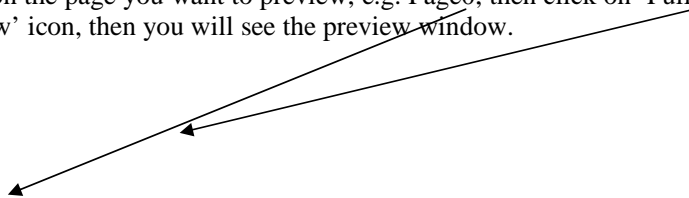

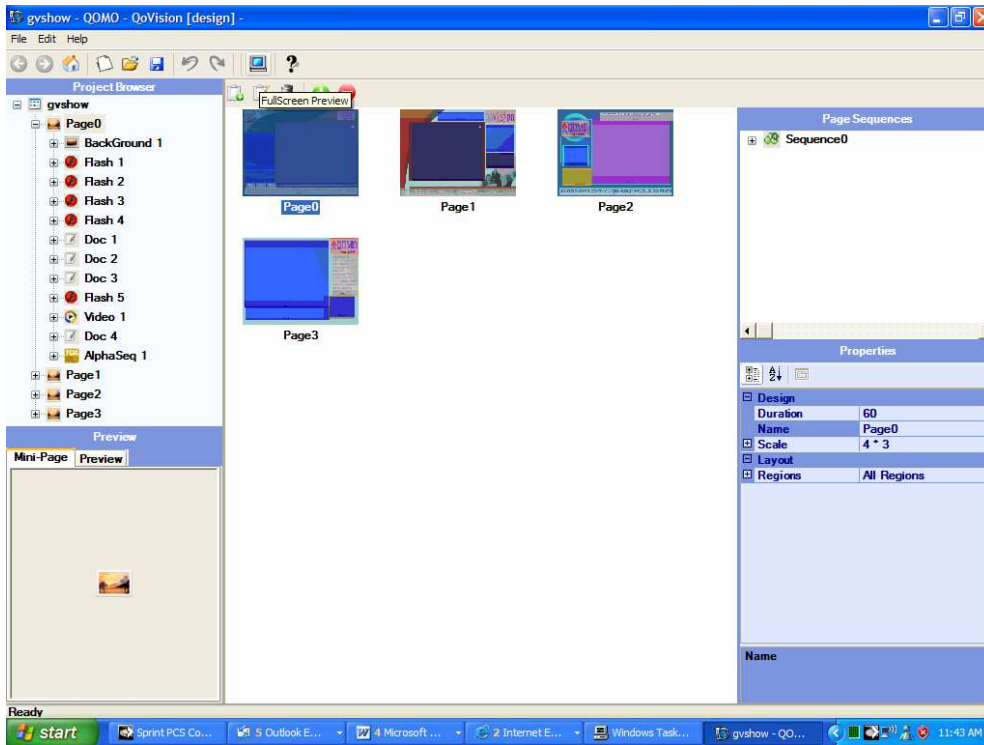


3.4.4 Double click on  and then click on the Browse button to find your jpg file.

#### 4. Preview page

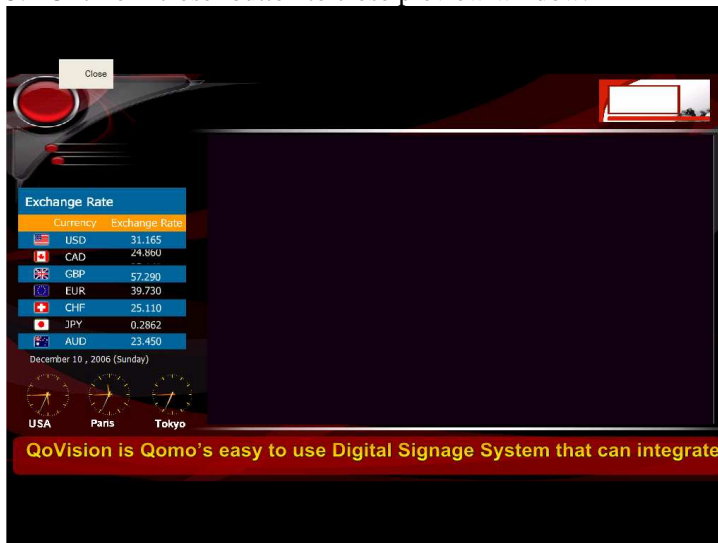
Click on the page you want to preview, e.g. Page0, then click on 'Full Screen preview' icon, then you will see the preview window.





## 5. Close preview window

5.1 Click on 'close' button to close preview window.



5.2 If you can't see the 'close' button, hit 'alt' and 'f4' keys together, then click on 'close' button to close the preview window.
