Access pre-installed whiteboard app in side bar menu, or from apps page.

*Note: You can activate palm erase using palm



- 1. Menu: Save, share, import/export, background
- 2. Exit: Close Whiteboard
- 3. QR Code: share whiteboard in QR Code
- 4. List: View saved whiteboards
- 5. Select: Select object
- 6. Pen: Change brush size and color
- 7. Eraser: Spot eraser
- 8. Clean all: Clear screen
- 9. Ruler: Ruler tools
- 10. Shape: Add different 2D/3D shapes
- 11. Partition: Split screen writing
- 12. Table: Add table
- 13. Mind Map: Template for chart
- 14. Sticky Notes: Write on moveable sticky note
- 15. Preview: Zoom in/Out of canvas
- 16. More: extra tools such as formulas, insert photo or video
- 17. Undo/Redo

Wireless Sharing

Bytello is a screen casting tool for smart phones, computers and tablets. Cast up to 9 different devices to screen. Supports Airplay (9 devices), Miracast (2 devices), chromecast (1 device), and webcasting (4 devices)



- 1. Click on casting icon cast or Bytello Share Appon BundleBoard i
- 2. Ensure all devices are connected to the same WIFI network.
- 3. Install client app on device <u>www.bytello.com/ssp</u> or use airplay, Miracast, or chromecast
- 4. Launch Bytello Share client app and select device.

Casting is also available through web browser (don't need to be on same wireless network). Access at: <u>share.bytello.com</u>
