


## Turn on System


## Remote Control

1		Short press: Turn the screen on/off Long press: Power off the unit
2		Short press: Open/close the input source list Long press: Lock/unlock the screen
3		Arrow keys, adjust the cursor position
4		Confirm selection or operation
5		Show/hide the main menu
6		Display the Android home screen
7		Return to the previous screen
8		Switch to OPS input source
9		Short press: Enable/disable freeze function Long press: Lock/unlock touch function
10		Short press: Take a screenshot Long press: Start/stop recording
11		Decrease volume
12		Mute/unmute
13		Increase volume






1. **Wifi Settings:** Set up wifi network, ethernet
2. **Device Management:** Set up external camera and microphone, bluetooth pairing
3. **Apps:** App Management/preferences
4. **Notifications:** System/app notifications
5. **Storage:** Check and Manage system storage
6. **Sound Settings:** Do not disturb, notification sounds, tap & click sounds, alarm sound
7. **Display Settings:** Different display options, lock screen, screen timeout, screen saver, launcher
8. **Wallpaper:** Wallpaper and Dark Theme Option
9. **Accessibility:** Different accessibility options such as display size and text
10. **Security & Privacy:** Lock screen and system security settings
11. **Location:** Location services settings
12. **Passwords & Accounts:** Passwords and synced account
13. **Digital Wellbeing & Parental Controls:** App usage data
14. **Google:** Google account settings
15. **Advanced:** Select Date format, set Stylus settings, Start up and shutdown scheduler, multi- window mode, gestures
16. **Administrator:** Admin Security settings, default start up item, set auto removal of items
17. **Bytello Account Mode:** Cloud based profile mode


Set Startup Channel

- Set up default input to power on to:

  3. Select Startrp Source and pick the start up channel of the screen.

**Program Shut-Down Time**




Schedule an automatic start up and shut down time to save energy by clicking on "Startup & shutdown".

\*Note: You can activate palm erase using palm





Control the board using the side arrow buttons




Annotate on top of any screen by clicking side arrow

## Wireless Sharing

Bytello is a screen casting tool for smart phones, computers and tablets. Cast up to 9 different devices to screen. Supports Airplay (9 devices), Miracast (2 devices), chromecast (1 device), and webcasting (4 devices)




1. Click on casting icon  or Bytello Share App on BundleBoard i
2. Ensure all devices are connected to the same WIFI network.
3. Install client app on device [www.bytello.com/ssp](http://www.bytello.com/ssp) or use airplay, Miracast, or chromecast
4. Launch Bytello Share client app and select device.

## Connecting Devices


### 1. Connecting Your External Computer



BundleBoard i has USB-C port available to connect to computer using USB-C Cable for image and touch


Connect your computer using a USB touch cable, VGA Cable and Audio Cable, HDMI Cable or DP Cable.

### 2. Outputting Display



You can output your BundleBoard panel to other displays through the HDMI port.

### 3. AV Connecting(HDMI IN)



Connect other external devices to the panel such as a DVD player or Camera using the HDMI port.
