

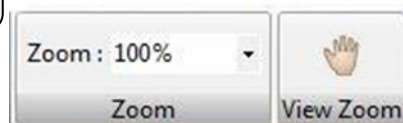


Visualizer 4.0

Quick Guide

View Tab

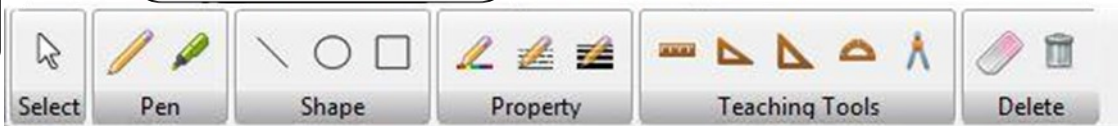
Digitally zoom in on objects under your document camera.



Pan around in your digitally zoomed image.

Annotation Tab

Use the arrow to select your annotations.



Use the Shape icons to draw straight lines for underlining or create perfect outlines of circles and squares to bring attention to items in your image.

Use the Teaching Tools to measure or draw lines, angles, arcs, sectors, or circles on your image.

Use the pen to draw annotations or write notes on your image.
Use the highlighter to draw attention to things in your image.

Use the Property icons to adjust your pen color, line style, and line thickness.

Use the eraser to delete selected annotations on your image or use the trash can to delete all the annotations on your image.

Tools Tab

Continuous Shot will allow you to take a self determined number of images at self determined intervals.

Record video from your document camera. If your computer has a microphone the software will record sounds.

Use the Screen Mask to conceal your document camera image until you are ready to share it with the audience.



Use the Snapshot icon to save a picture of your image. The image will also be available in your image list thumbnails for easy access.

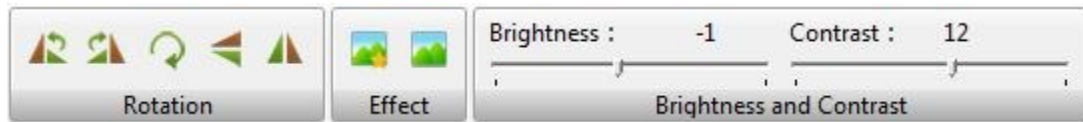
Capture allows you to copy a self determined part of your image and paste it into other applications.

Use the Create PDF icon to create a .pdf document to easily share images and annotations you created with the visualizer software.

Image Tab

Use the Rotation icons to rotate or mirror your image.

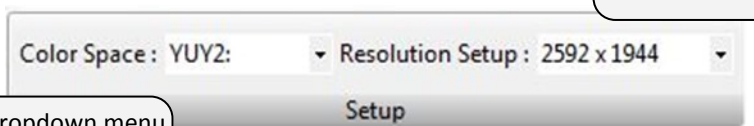
Use the Brightness and Contrast Sliding bars to adjust your document camera image.



Use the Effect icons to create artistic effects on your image, such as, black and white, emboss, or negative.

Control Tab

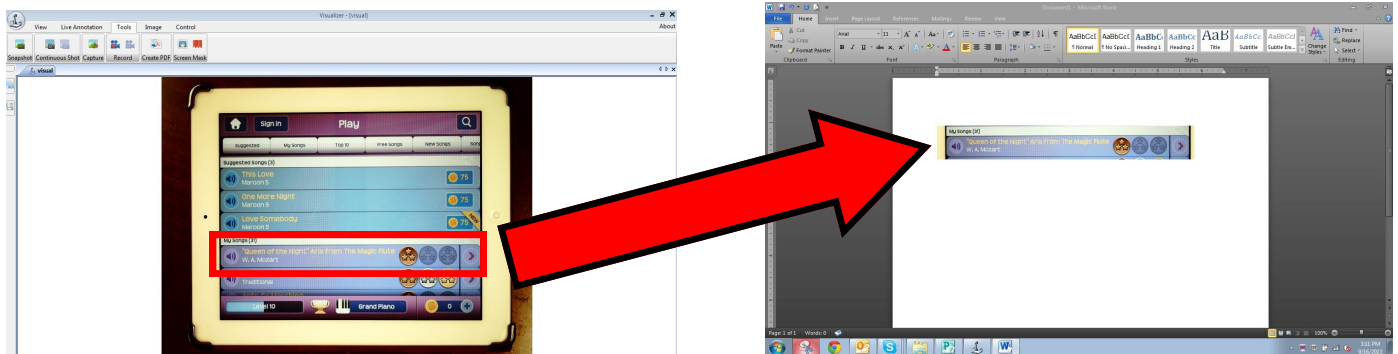
Use the Resolution Setup dropdown menu to adjust the resolution of your document camera image.



Use the Color Space dropdown menu to select the format that gives you the best color option.

Capture an Image

1. Click on the Capture icon under the Tools tab.
2. Click and draw a rectangle around the part of the image you would like to capture.
3. Open the application you would like to paste the captured image into.
4. Locate the area you would like to paste the captured image and paste the image either by clicking ctrl + v or right click on the page and select paste.



Create a PDF

1. Take a snapshot of the image you would like to use to create your PDF file. (Usually people use this to capture and share images that they annotated on.)
2. Click the Create PDF icon.
3. Click Add and select an image you would like to use to create your PDF file.
4. Click Create PDF and save your PDF file.
